

2019-2020 AHSAA Bylaw Changes

1. Approved to return the 2018-19 revenue share (between 1.4 and 2 million) the last week of June. This amount would be based on the final AHSAA financial position for the 2018-19 fiscal year. Schools would receive checks in July.
2. If a school's varsity football team competes in a regular season contest during week zero, that school's junior varsity (JV) or freshmen football teams may begin competition the following Monday. (This year that Monday would be August 26, 2019).
3. Amendment to Rule I. Eligibility. Section 12. Exception 3. Bona Fide Move. Divorce:
*The eligibility of a student whose parents are divorced **or never married** is determined by the following:*

(c) For parents who were never married, the one-time custody exemption may be granted as long as both parents are listed on a state issued birth certificate and all other eligibility requirements are met.
3. Amendment to Rule I. Eligibility. Section 8. Amateur Rule:

*(f) A student who has lost his/her amateur standing may be reinstated after the lapse of one high school season, **or until reinstated by the Central Board of Control** for the sport in which he/she has become professional provided he/she has not persisted in breaking the amateur rule.*
