440-Yard Dash—A. Rogers (Butler), Doughty (Tuscaloosa Co.), Oliver (Phillips), Brownell (Phillips). Time 53 seconds (New state record.)

Half Mile Run—Minnis (Phillips), Mathews (Albertville), Gober (Ensley), Pierce (Butler). Time, 2 minutes 6 seconds. (New state record.)

Mile Run—Maumanee (Phillips), Elder (Snead), Pierce (Butler), Williams (Butler). Time 4 minutes, 48 seconds.

Discus Throw—Hundertmark (Tuscaloosa), Norris (Snead), Smith (Jeffcohi), McNeil (Albertville). Distance, 109 feet.

Shot Put—Briner (Ensley), McCollum (Ensley), Hundertmark (Tuscaloosa), Pritchett (Snead). Distance 42 feet, 4 inches.

Broad Jump—McKenzie (Baldwin), McNeil (Albertville), Sharp (Ensley), Glover (Simpson). Distance 19 feet, 9½ inches.

High Jump—Sunmerlin (Butler). Waters (Baldwin), Morton (Glencoe), Monte (Bessemer) and Pierce (Phillips), tie for fourth. Height: 5 feet, 7 inches.

220-Yard Hurdles—Davis (Phillips), Thomas (Jeffcohi), G. Hughes (Tuscaloosa), B Hughes (Tuscaloosa). Time, :26.4 (new state record).

Pole Vault—Rutland (Lee County), Phillips (Ensley), Propst (Baldwin), Casey (Glencoe). Height: 11 feet 1⅝ inches (new state record).

Half-Mile Relay—Phillips (Wills, Day, Hillin, Brownell); Simpson Jeffcohi, Ensley. Time 1:37.1 (new state record).
