



State Championship Meet

Location: Martin Aquatics Center, 664 Biggio Dr, Auburn University, AL 36849

**Warm up lane assignments and times will be posted at each pool.*

Format: Swimming: This will be a prelim/ final meet following the AHSAA State Meet order of events. The girls' heats will be swum before the boys' heats for each swim event.

This will be a prelim/semi/final session meet. The meet will consist of 11 dives, and cuts will be made after 5 dives (20 divers in Class 6A-7A and 12 divers in Class 1A-5A) and 8 dives (16 divers for Class 6A-7A and 8 divers for Class 1A-5A). Divers must submit dive sheets to www.divemeets.com by 9:00am on Wednesday, November 29.

Rules: This meet will be conducted under the auspices of the Alabama High School Athletic Association and the 2017-2018 NFHS Swimming and Diving Rules Book and as an Observed meet under Southeastern Swimming, Inc., of United States Swimming.

Eligibility: All participants must be eligible under AHSAA rules. Only high school varsity teams and individuals representing high schools are eligible for the state meet. All participants in any meet must be accompanied by a faculty member from their school.

Entry A team may enter only four (4) individuals per event and one (1) relay team per event. A

Limit: participant may enter a maximum of four (4) events (diving events included), no more than two (2) of which may be individual events. Over entries will be deleted from the fifth entry on. Events competed in at the Sectional Meets will count against the event limit at the State Meet.

Relay alternates must be submitted to Sarah Stallkamp by Wednesday Nov 29, 2017, 9:00am.

Note: Schools must enter their relay teams with individual names. It shall not count as an entry unless the competitor actually competes in the event. All students included on the State Meet roster may swim in the prelims, swim-offs and/or finals of relays provided he/she does not exceed the permitted entries for the meet. A relay alternate may be listed beside an entry's name, but any substitution must be made prior to the start of the meet. Relay cards are due at the beginning of warm-ups each day.

Diving Warm-ups:

8:00am-9:00am – Open Boards

9:00am-10:00am – Warm-up for Boys only

TBD – following completion of Boys event, there will be 1 hour warm-up for Girls only

Entries: All State Meet qualifiers will be sent directly to the meet director by the Sectional Meet hosts. A Psych Sheet and roster of Athletes for the State Meet will be posted on the AHSAA website on Monday. Schools wishing to add a relay alternate who is not on the posted roster must contact the meet director (ses0032@auburn.edu), by Wednesday, November 29 at 9am. Any swimmer, diver or relay who fails to compete in an event for which they are entered or qualify for will be disqualified from further participation in the meet.

Qualified divers must complete an entry and dive list on www.divemeets.com by 9am on Wednesday, November 29.

Entry Fees: There are no entry fees for the State Meet

Scoring: Top 16 [6A-7A] & Top 8 (1A-5A) Relays/ Swimmers will be scored as follows:

Individual (6A-7A): [20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1]

Relay (6A-7A): [40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2]

Individual (1A-5A): (20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11)

Awards: 1A-5A Top Female Team and Top Male Team Champion and Runner-Up will receive Team Awards.

6A-7A Top Female Team and Top Male Team Champion and Runner-Up will receive Team Awards.

Awards will be given for the top three individuals or relays in each event for each classification.

Amenities: Hospitality services will be provided for officials and volunteers. A first aid station will be located on the pool deck and staffed with an AHSAA trainer. Concessions will also be available in the spectator area

Parking: Parking will be available in the Coliseum lot, McWhorter Center lot and along Biggio Dr both North and South of Samford Ave. There will be no charge for parking. All vehicles must be parked in a legal parking space. Vehicles parked on the grass, in fire lanes, tow away zones and in areas other than what are listed above may be ticketed or towed at the owner's expense.

Admission: \$10.00 per day. Fees are payable to AHSAA. Tickets may be purchased in advance at <https://gofan.co/app/school/AHSAA/Swimming-Diving>. Advance sale tickets will be downloaded to

your smart phone. Users who do not have a smart phone will not be able to utilize this service and must purchase tickets at the door.

Coaches: Only AHSAA certified coaches will be allowed on the deck. Coaches must show their AHSAA coaching card in order to access the deck. The Auburn staff will have an up to date print out of C2C certified coaches.

Officials: All persons interesting in officiating should contact the Meet Referee. The Meet Referee will select officials and assign positions for the meet. The number of officials selected to work the meet will be limited.

State Meet Qualifying Procedure

Individuals and relays placing in the Top 3 in each event shall automatically qualify for the state meet. In the event that multiple swimmers tie for 3rd place, both swimmers/divers shall qualify for state. Any relay or swimmer who achieves the posted State Meet time standard at the Sectional Meets shall also qualify. These times must be achieved during the Sectional Meet or obtain the qualifying score in diving. Any relay or swimmer who achieves the following time standard at the Sectional Meets shall also qualify. These times must be achieved during the event of record.

Note: Relay lead-offs and initial distance efforts will not be recognized as State Meet qualifying times.
